The Postdoctoral Fellow will initiate and conduct experiments for testing candidate therapeutic agents for posttraumatic stress disorder (PTSD) using behavioral screening assays.

- Assists in designing, developing, executing, and implementing scientific experiments related to drug development in a non-mammalian model
- Performs laboratory research utilizing experimental protocols which will involve specialized procedures such as exposure of zebrafish larvae to a stimulus, measurement of response using behavioral recording equipment and software, and testing of medicinal compounds for ability to modify response to stimuli
